The IPADS will be purchased with this money once we have bought and received the cart to house all the IPADS.

Teacher Accounts--At this time each teacher will receive \$10 per student in their class.

Volunteer Interest Forms/Survey Monkey is ready to go out. Debbie will meet with Raquel Gwynn (Principal) to push this form out.
